- Swimming with foul weather gear and PFDs, inflating manual and automatic PFDs
- Inflation and righting of a life raft, boarding while abandoning ship and from the water
- Swim-tow and assistance to injured crew members for boarding from the water
- Safe use of pyrotechnics (flares) \*
